	1	Attend an Into Officiating Course (Previously know as the Beginner Umpire Course) Booking via England Netball website: England Netball Officiating	£40	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Into Officiating courses will comprise of two 2-hour interactive virtual sessions delivered via Zoom. Learners will each receive a hard copy resource, a whistle and a rule book prior to the course. Practical element sourced through County. Mentoring through County HUB. Into Officiating assessment is arranged through County Officiating Lead. Each learner will receive an electronic resource to support the course delivery. Once the virtual course is completed, the learner will be invited to take their C Award Written Paper online. The cost of the course (including one attempt at the C Award Written Paper – usually an additional £10)

	3	Attend a C Award Course Attendance at this course is valid for 2 years. Booking via England Netball website. England Netball Officiating	£45	
	4	Take your written assessment This is a 30 minutes online exam which assesses learners' knowledge of the rules. It consists of 20 multiple-choice questions and a small selection of text questions. A pass on the written paper is valid for 2 years.	£10	Learners attending online course will receive a link to the Written paper within 6 months. 	5	Arrange a pre-assessment. A pre-assessment is an opportunity for an Assessor to observe you and let you know if you are ready to proceed to your practical assessment. Application forms are on the Surrey website. Officiating - Surrey County Netball (surreynetball.co.uk)	Expenses paid directly to pre-assessor by learner.
